

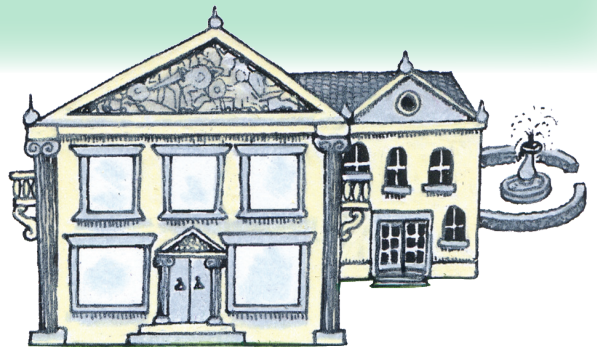
Proofreading a Story

REMEMBER After writing something, it is a good idea to read it through to make sure there are no mistakes.
